forwardFocus aims to prepare ex-offenders for employment in industry sectors that are driving regional employment and high demand occupations within those sectors.

Returning to the community from jail or prison is a complex transition for most offenders, as well as for their families and communities. Upon reentering society, former offenders are likely to struggle with substance abuse, lack of adequate education and job skills, limited housing options, and mental health issues.

Workforce and Judicial systems and community leaders across the state have recognized the urgent need to lower the numbers of current prisoners and the rate of recidivism, in order to decrease state prison costs and increase public safety.

Working to reduce recidivism, the State and its workforce community are focused on improved employment outcomes for the supervised population through the creative and effective aligning of training, education, and other services for this population with the industries and employers driving regional employment.
