CHAPTER 7: STATE POLICIES AND ORGANIZATIONAL CHARTS

State Legislation

AB 2288 (A. Burke, Chapter 692, Statutes of 2016) modified the Unemployment Insurance Code to require the State Board and each local board to ensure that federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 funds respectively awarded by them for preapprenticeship training in the building and construction trades fund programs and services that follow Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3). The law also requires that providers of preapprenticeship programs funded with WIOA funds help increase the representation of women in those trades by developing a plan for outreach and retention of women in these preapprenticeship programs.
