The AB1111: Removing Barriers to Employment initiative is to provide individuals with barriers to employment the services they need to enter, participate in, and complete broader workforce preparation, training, and education programs aligned with regional labor market needs. Those who complete these programs should have the skills and competencies necessary to successfully enter the labor market, retain employment, and earn wages that lead to self-sufficiency, and eventually, economic security.

Five regional stakeholder meetings are scheduled to give you an opportunity to learn about the legislation and ask questions about the initiative being developed by the California Workforce Development Board. It is anticipated that the CWDB will release the AB 1111 Request for Applications in March of 2019.
