PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Through convening labor, workforce and industry partners, they are establishing a system of structured pathways to High Road Construction Careers.
- The North State Builds MC-3 Program brings together 3 Building Trades, 3 Workforce Development Boards, 8 American Job Centers of California (AJCCs), several Community Based Organizations (CBO), Probation, Parole, Adult Education and others.
