The California Mobility Center (CMC) is a nonprofit focused on reducing the time it takes to get clean technologies into the marketplace. The goal of the CMC is to develop an innovation hub in California's capitol for clean mobility, creating an environment and support system for start-ups and established mobility companies to collaborate on advanced and innovative techniques. This hub will accelerate the adoption of clean mobility technology, shape the future of mobility and help California reach its climate goals.

The project will deliver advanced manufacturing and clean mobility workforce training to priority populations, adding three new community-based organizations (CBOs) and training partners to help reach underserved communities in the Capitol region. Building on the training curriculum currently supporting the emerging Clean Mobility ecosystem, the project will advance innovative research, training, and program design in the mobility industry. The CMC plans to scale clean transportation technology and training to meet the needs of employers throughout the state, leveraging research conducted by Valley Vision.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Outreach to priority populations and provide workforce readiness and technical training to prepare participants for the high-demand careers.
- Supportive services and case management to ensure the ongoing success and retention of participants.
- An industry-based workforce development committee within the CMC will identify the skills needed to be successful in the growing industry sector of transportation and its related supply chains. The training will enhance access to job skills for people from underserved and under-resourced communities.
- Career paths that increase economic mobility for employees and leverage the Sacramento Valley Manufacturing Initiative (SVMI) apprenticeship structure to standardized skills across the region.
