Update on RPU TA Plans and CTI List

Regional TA Plans - Following the development and presentation of customized technical assistance plans for all fourteen (at the time) RPUs in early 2020, the onset of the pandemic resulted in an immediate shift in priorities for every RPU and the local workforce areas they represent. Over a period of several months, CWA provided a wide range of training and individualized services that reflected needs arising from COVID-19 and its effects workforce development system operations. Last winter, discussions with Regional Organizers as well as with local board Directors and staff suggested that system capacity had expanded to the point where many regions were then able to participate in TA and/or training activities. From January through March 2021, CWA's RPI TA team met with regional representatives to re-examine the original TA plans, discuss whether planned services were still relevant, and identify, as needed, changes in individualized TA or training services. For several RPUs, changes, which range from minor to substantial, have been made to the goals/activities outlined in the plans. Revised plans are being finalized by our team and will be sent in mid-May to the twelve RPUs which engaged in discussions with us last quarter. Once we have received approval from each RPU, we will immediately begin to provide TA and training services, as updated. The one exception to this schedule is the Orange RPU, for which will have already begun to provide services under their revised plan. CWA anticipates completing the majority of the TA plan services by the end of September 2021.

CTI List Update - The CTI RFP 2021 was closed on April 30, 2021, and CWA will have a new list of CTI providers by July 1, 2021. Please check with your local procurement policies if your organization can "piggyback" on CWA's procurement to use CTI.
