**CALIFORNIA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD STATEMENT
ON MASS SHOOTING AT SANTA CLARA RAIL YARD**

SACRAMENTO – California Workforce Development Board (CWDB) Executive Director Tim Rainey issued the following statement regarding the mass shooting at the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority light rail facility:

“The California Workforce Development Board is devastated by the tragic loss of critical frontline workers at the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) this morning. These workers are the latest victims of the mass shooting epidemic that plagues our nation, dedicated professionals who have committed their careers to help make sure that millions of people in the South Bay can get to and from work and live their lives, safely and reliably every day. I join the families of these workers, and the brothers and sisters of the ATU Local 265 in mourning the loss of lives, and stand in solidarity against gun violence in our communities.”
