In partnership with the Humboldt-Del Norte Building Trades Council, CalPoly Humboldt University is leading a project to develop a new High Road Construction Careers partnership to provide pathways into apprenticeship for underserved communities. The partnership will cover Humboldt and Del Norte counties.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- As an emerging HRCC, they will build out a stakeholder network of contractors, local unions, community-based organizations, colleges and tribes, and advocate for policies that create apprenticeship opportunities for program participants on upcoming infrastructure developments.
- The Humboldt Del Norte Building Trades will oversee the pre-apprenticeship programs and forecast apprenticeship opportunities to ensure that the supply of participants matches the demand from contractors and their trade union partners.
