

The Monterey Bay Collaborative (MBC) is a high road construction careers partnership that prepares participants from underserved communities for success in the building trades. This project serves Monterey, Santa Cruz, and San Benito counties.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- The program includes 350 hours of training that includes a daily physical exercise component, hands-on projects for various trades, advanced drug testing prior to placement, a 20-hour Bootcamp and interview preparation.
- MBC collaborate with local employers in the construction industry to provide up to 100 hours of paid work experience through participant placements for additional field experience.
