The North Central Counties Consortium (NCCC) is leading a partnership that provides underserved communities in rural areas with onramps to middle-class careers in the building and construction trades through rigorous pre-apprenticeship training and supportive services. The project serves Shasta, Trinity, Lassen, Tehama, Modoc, Siskiyou, Colusa, Glenn, Sutter, Yuba, Butte, and Plumas counties.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Participants are provided with weekly stipends as they complete their pre-apprenticeship coursework.
- NCCC also provides participants with the work boots, clothing and tools that they need to start an apprenticeship program.
- The expanded math curriculum prepares participants for careers in the mechanical trades.
