The SETA Public Pathways Partnership will connect underserved populations in Sacramento with career, education, training, and skills in high-road, high-demand career pathways. The goal is to enroll 300 residents in training programs in the Public Sector/Business, Healthcare, Biotechnology, and Community Health Worker pathways. The partnership will provide a regionally centralized approach that connects target populations with job training, certifications, enrollment into postsecondary education, and employment. Navigators will conduct outreach throughout the region to engage individuals from target populations and connect them to SETA and its partner agencies. Individuals from the targeted neighborhoods who are enrolled in training will be provided with case management, supportive services, placed into internships, on-the-job training, and placed into employment.

### TARGET POPULATION

This project will serve English Language Learners, homeless and housing insecure, justice-involved individuals, people with disabilities, Veterans, Youth (18-24), low-income workers, immigrants/refugees, Aggie Square community residents, and other under-resourced community residents.

### PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- 300 individuals from the target populations will be enrolled into career and training programs.
- 77% will complete training and receive an industry-recognized credential.
- 77% of training project graduates will achieve measurable skill gains (training/sector specific).
- 70% of training project graduates will be eligible for employment in training-related industries.
- 20% placement in Postsecondary Education.
- 10% Career Advancement/Promotion for Incumbent Workers.
